- Provides appropriate medical monitoring for phase I and phase II clinical trials
- May recruit clinical investigators and negotiate study design and costs.
- Develops and maintains relationships with thought leaders in the medical community
- Prepare manuscripts, abstracts and presentations for scientific meetings
- May also participate in proposal generation, feasibility assessments, and review of proposals/contracts for medical services.

Qualifications: M.D. degree and 5+ years experience managing phase I and phase II clinical trials in the United States. Strongly prefer experience managing clinical trials in Oncology or Immunotherapy arena.
